In this presentation, we outline the basics of their recommendations and some additional measures we have taken at our facilities to ensure your safety.

Keep your distance

Keep your distance from others both indoors and outdoors. Aim at a distance of about 1,5 meter from each other.



Stay home if you feel unwell

If you have cold symptoms, cough or fever, you should avoid contact with other people. This is a very important measure in order to avoid the spread of Covid-19.



Wash your hands often

Our hands are a good environment for infectious agents. The infection is transmitted to others when we shake hands. Wash your hands regularly with soap and hot water, for at least 20 seconds.



Cough and sneeze into your elbow

When you cough or sneeze, tiny droplets containing infectious agents spread to your immediate surroundings. If you cough or sneeze into your elbow, you can prevent the spread of the disease and at the same time avoid contaminating your hands.



Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth

Infection is spread through membranes in the eyes, nose and mouth. Therefore it is important to avoid touching these areas. If you still need to, wash your hands both before and after.

HOW TO WASH YOUR HANDS

Washing your hands regularly is one of the most important actions you can take to avoid the spread of Covid-19. Infectious substances easily stick to hands and they spread further when you are in contact with other people or surfaces.

When at our facilities, try to wash your hands often with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.

ADDITIONAL MEASURES

WE TAKE AT OUR FACILITIES



Alcoholic gel is provided at the entrance of each building.



All surfaces subject to physical contact are cleaned and disinfected regularly.



We have reduced the amount of furniture in each room to make social distancing easier. It is furnished so that a social distance of 1,5 meter is kept at all times.



All our personnel have their temperature tested on a daily basis. To be able to work at our facilities, their temperature must not exceed 37.5 degrees Celsius.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING AT ARCTIC FALLS

We encourage the following:



Only the team leader should be in the reception at the time of check-in. Our staff will always use face masks when interacting with you and your team.



Bring food and snacks to your workstation to avoid crowding.



Only one team are allowed in the kitchen and social rooms at the same time. The social distance between the team members should be kept at about 1,5 meter.



Try to contact the staff at the facility by phone, walkie-talkie or email instead of going around looking for them. Meetings can also be held online, by using services such as Microsoft Teams.

THE CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

AT VITBERGET PROVING GROUND

To guarantee a smooth and safe arrival, we have decided upon the following check-in procedure.



A few weeks prior to arrival, we send out a check-list for you to fill in, so that we have all the name badges ready to be distributed by your team leader.



Only the team leader is allowed in the reception at the time of check-in to pick up name badges, keys etc.



A plexiglass panel is placed between the visitor and the receptionist.



The welcome briefing is held in a spacious conference room where social distancing is made possible. If you wish, the welcome briefing can also be held online using Microsoft Teams.



Face masks are not mandatory in Sweden according to Swedish Public Health Authority, but our personnel always use them upon visiting the workshops.



The facility tour takes place in different cars. Our personnel take the lead and communicate with your team through walkie-talkies.
